## **Achievements - Scholastics:**

Academic excellence merited high positions by students in the AISSE and AISSCE circuits. The board results indeed added zip to life with centum in Class X and Class XII.

A spectacular 89% distinction in Class XII and 93% in Class X has put our school on the top of the charts among all schools in the city. **A detailed analysis for you.**

In the AISSCE 2019 for XII, 112 of 126 students secured distinction and 14 students secured first class. T Megha emerged as topper in the Science stream

with 98.4% and NEHA M NAMBIAR emerged as topper in the Commerce Stream with 97.6%.

In the AISSE 2019, 143 of 154 students secured distinction and 11 secured first class. AJAYKRISHNAN K emerged school topper with 99 % .

8 students of Std XII and 11 students of Std X won the CBSE merit certificates of the top 0.1% of successful candidates in the country.

This coffee table book was released by the Union MHRD Minister Mr Ramesh Pokhriyal and CBSE Chairperson Ms Anita Karwal, IAS at the CBSE National Conference at New Delhi on 2nd November 2019.
